Get Behind the Scenes!

Behind the Scenes is an hour long, guided tour for small groups of people. A knowledgeable interpreter will suit you up in rubber boots (you will be going to slippery areas!) and take you behind the staff-only doors of the aquarium. There are four to five stops on the tour. Some of our Aquarium animals are only found in our behind-the-scenes tanks! You will have an opportunity to feed some animals, learn about our care protocol and how we keep the animals healthy including the water systems that filter and recirculate our water.

You will also learn more about what the different departments at the Huntsman Marine Science Centre do, including research and education. Once you are in our wet lab you will look at locally collected Bay of Fundy microplankton under a microscope and examine some strange preserved fish specimens. The animals themselves are always changing behind-the-scenes based on what is going on in the Aquarium, so there is always something unique to see and learn!

Your admissions, memberships and donations to the Fundy Discovery Aquarium help us continue to inspire people to discover the importance of our oceans and become stewards for our marine environments.


